Efficiency vs. Coverage in Transit Planning

RIDERSHIP GOAL: Maximize Ridership

To maximize ridership you think like a business, choosing which markets you will enter.

The straight lines offer density, walkability, and an efficient transit path, so you focus frequent, attractive service there.

Performance Measure: PRODUCTIVITY
Ridership relative to cost



COVERAGE GOAL: Some Service for Everyone

To maximize coverage, think like a government service. Try to serve everyone, even those in expensive to serve places.

You get more routes covering everyone, but less frequency, more complexity, and lower ridership.

Performance Measure: ACCESS

% of population and jobs near some service



Both goals are important, but they lead in opposite directions



Ridership Goal

- Think like a business
- Focus where ridership potential is highest
- Maximum reduction in driving, congestion



Coverage Goal

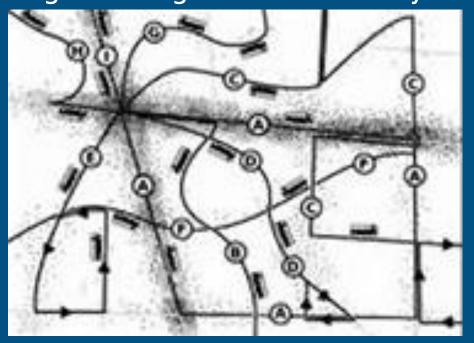
- Access for all
- Services for hard to serve areas, despite low ridership
- Lifeline access for everyone

High Coverage: Access for Everyone

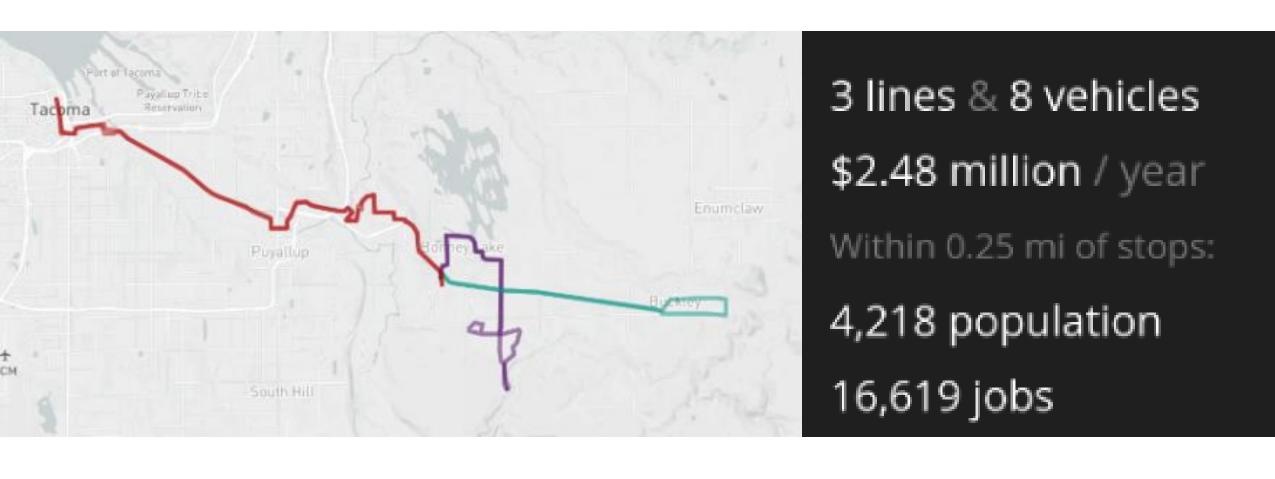


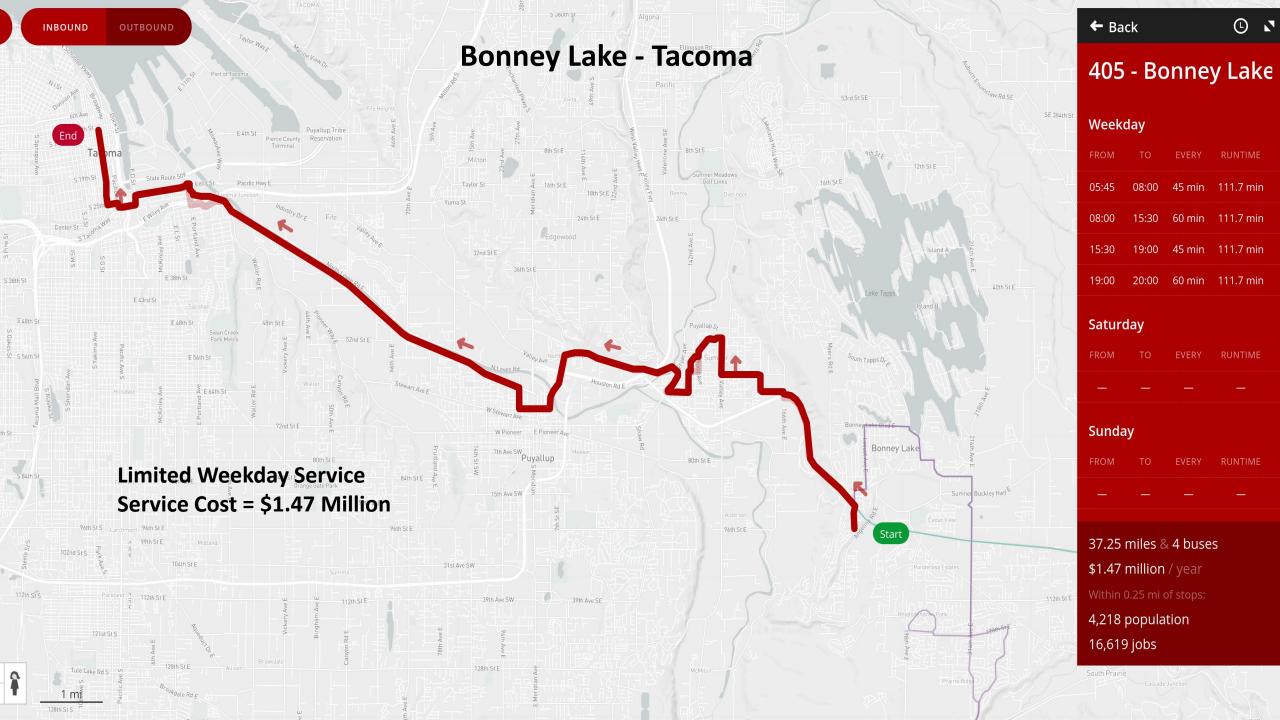

Revenue Increase Scenarios

Pierce Transit Six Year Sales Tax Forecast

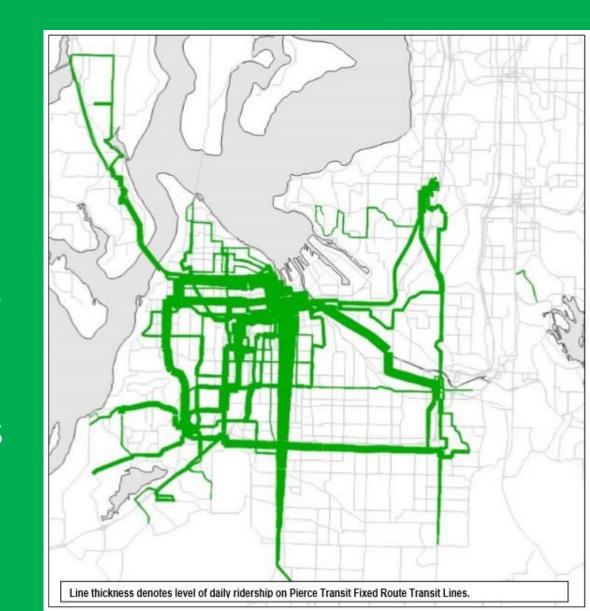
- Current Sales Tax .6%
- Assumptions
 - 5.5% annual increase
 - Current PTBA
 - Collections begin 2020
 - Each tenth of a percent increase ~\$70 million
- 0.9% Collections additional \$210M



Pierce Transit Six Year Forecast: 0.7% Sales Tax

Additional revenue would allow us to add approximately 60,000 service hours.

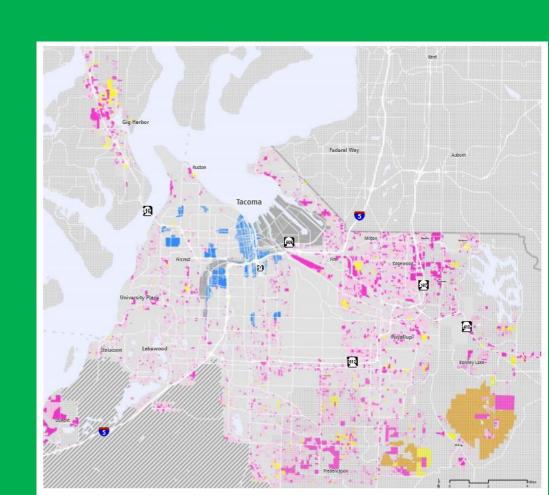
- Brings total hours up to 560,130
- 12% more service hours than baseline
- Improve service on trunk routes 2, 3, and 4 to
 15 minute in the peak and partial mid-day
- Weekday span improvements on urban routes
- Minor span improvements on weekends
- Potential ridership increase of 4% to 6%



Pierce Transit Six Year Forecast: 0.8% Sales Tax

Additional revenue would allow us to add approximately 120,000 service hours.

- Brings total hours up to 620,130
- 24% more service hours than baseline
- Improves service on trunk routes 2, 3, and 4 to
 15 minute in the peak and partial mid-day
- Enough hours to create a 5th Trunk Route
- Peak hour service added to 22 routes
- Off peak service added to 18 routes
- Weekend span and frequency improvements
- Potential daily ridership increase of 28%



Pierce Transit Six Year Forecast: 0.9% Sales Tax

Additional revenue would allow us to add approximately 180,000 service hours.

- Brings total hours up to 680,130
- 36% more service hours than baseline
- Meets incremental growth target outlined in Long Range Plan 15 years early
- Peak hour service added to 37 routes
- Off peak service added to 33 routes
- Substantial improvements to weekend span and frequency
- Potential daily ridership increase of 40%
