What to do in the event of an accident...

IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE ACCIDENT

- **1.** Help anyone injured, then call 911 to request medical assistance (if needed)
- **2.** *Place emergency reflective triangles* around the vehicle:
 - One-way Street or Freeway: 10, 100 and 200 feet behind
 - Two-way Street: 10 and 100 feet behind and 100 feet in front
 - Hill or Curved Street: Place for visibility but no further than 500 feet
- **3.** <u>Distribute</u> copies of the appropriate type of information card to those involved and then *collect*:
 - Drivers: Driver Information Exchange cards (blue)
 - You: Vanpool Information Exchange card (green)
 - Witnesses: Vanpool Courtesy card*

Do not admit fault or discuss details with anyone outside of Pierce Transit or law enforcement.

Refer **all information requests to** Pierce Transit's Risk Management Department at **253.983.3477**

- **4.** *Take photos* of the following:
 - All 4 sides of the Vanpool vehicle
 - All 4 sides of the surrounding area (turn your back to the van and take a photo from each side)
 - All 4 sides of any damaged vehicles
 - Any damage to objects or property
- **5.** <u>If you can't drive</u> the vehicle <u>or there are injuries</u>, call Pierce Transit at 253.581.8000 and follow the prompts to Vanpool Emergency

What to do in the event of an accident...

WITHIN 24 HOURS - Vanpool driver only

- 1. <u>Notify Pierce Transit</u> by calling 253.581.8000 or emailing Vanpool@PierceTransit.org
- 2. Complete Pierce Transit's <u>online Collision Report</u> at PierceTransit.org/CollisionReport or use your mobile phone to scan the QR code



- 3. <u>Upload all cards</u> (Driver Information Exchange and Vanpool Courtesy) in the online Collision Report or scan cards & email to Vanpool@PierceTransit.org
- **4.** If law enforcement was <u>at the scene of the accident</u>, submit copies of any completed accident reports to **Vanpool@PierceTransit.org**

If law enforcement was not at the scene, the accident damage is likely to exceed \$1000, the other party did not have insurance, or someone sustained an injury, you must complete an Online State of Washington Motor Vehicle Collision Report (OMVCR) and provide a copy to Pierce Transit.
