What is Pierce Transit Runner?

It is an innovative on-demand service created especially for people with Department of Defense ID cards needing transportation services to and from the Joint Base Lewis-McChord military base.

Why should I ride?

The Runner is a great way to get around without the hassles of parking and the stress of driving in traffic. It's a great option for those who are new to Pierce County looking for a cost-effective transportation solution to get to and from base. The Runner also connects with other local transit services at Lakewood Transit Center.

Hours of operation

The JBLM Runner zone is active in peak morning and afternoon hours:

Monday-Friday: 7 a.m. - 9:30 a.m. and 3 p.m. - 6:30 p.m.

Service does not operate on federal holidays or Christmas Eve.

Getting Started

Where can I ride?

Ride JBLM Runner to and from four locations on base, and four locations in Lakewood. Connect with other local or regional transit services, shops, restaurants, recreation and healthcare options.

You can request a ride from any of the eight stops. Check out the interactive map on PierceTransit.org/ Runner to see the route in detail.

How do I request a pick up?

It's easy to ride. Just go to one of the boarding locations when you are ready to be picked up, and call 253.377.4380. Tell the agent your exact location.

What does it cost to ride?

Fares are \$2 for adults, \$1 for passengers with a Regional Reduced Fare Permit. Youth 6 through 18 are eligible for Pierce Transit's \$1.00 Youth fare through August 31, 2022.

Starting September 1, 2022, youth 18 and younger ride FREE. Riders age 13 and older should show the driver their Youth ORCA card (and tap), or their school ID if they have it with them.

There are four ways to pay:

- 1. Pay cash in the farebox.
- 2. Pay with your phone using a mobile app. For details visit PierceTransit.org/apps.
- 3. Show the driver your valid **ORCA card**.
- 4. Show the driver your valid All Day Pass.
