



Reduced Fare Card Fact Sheet

There is a more affordable way to get where you need to go. With ORCA LIFT, income-qualified adults have the convenience of an ORCA card, at a lower price.

The ORCA LIFT card allows riders to pay \$1 for one-way trips on:

- Link light rail, Sounder commuter rail and ST Express buses
- King County Metro buses
- King County Water Taxi
- Seattle Monorail
- Seattle Streetcar
- Kitsap Transit buses and eastbound fast ferry
- Everett Transit buses
- Community Transit buses

Eligibility is based on your household income. Listed below is the maximum monthly income* to qualify for **ORCA LIFT**, organized by family size.

How ORCA LIFT Works:

- If you qualify for ORCA LIFT, the first card is free.
- If your ORCA LIFT card is lost, stolen or damaged, replacement cards are \$3.
- An ORCA LIFT card lasts for two years after you receive it. You can renew by reapplying via application process.
- You can reload your ORCA LIFT card with E-purse value or a transit pass at any ORCA card kiosk station or online.
- If you do not have enough money to cover your next trip, the ORCA LIFT card will allow you to travel with a negative balance of up to -\$2.75.
- Acceptable documents for qualification or eligibility status are listed online.
